Plot Twists - Daniel

This week, Dan Shryock shared with us about the life of Daniel. Here are his takeaway points with discussion questions for your group:

- 1. Always try to see God's perspective.**
 - *What makes seeing from God's perspective challenging? How can we learn to see from His perspective better?*
 - *"God is always in control of who is in control." What do you think about that statement? How do you come to terms with that statement with the ungodly leaders in the world or even ungodly bosses at work?*
- 2. Remember that we are citizens of another kingdom.**
 - *What does Hebrews 11:13-16 encourage us to think and do?*
 - *How does keeping our heavenly citizenship in mind help us to contribute to society here on earth?*
- 3. Reveal God to this world through your actions and attitude.**
 - *Read Daniel 6:3-5. How did Daniel become distinguished? What are some practical ways that we can model this type of spirit in us?*
- 4. Know who you are.**
 - *Read 1 Peter 2:9. What does this verse say about both our position and our purpose? What are different ways that we can "proclaim the excellencies of Him"?*
- 5. Be blameless.**
 - *Read Philippians 2:14-15. What makes us "blameless"? What makes actually living out verse 14 difficult?*
- 6. Don't compromise.**
 - *Read Romans 12:2. What are some areas that you are challenged to be conformed to the world or to compromise? How can your group pray for you, hold you accountable and encourage you?*
