## The Question:

How do we avoid pride and arrogant comparison while pursuing holiness and obedience?

Biblical View of obedience (Luke 17:7-10)

- 1. A disciple should never <u>forget</u> his <u>position</u> before God.
- 2. Obedience does not <u>obligate</u> God to the disciple.
- 3. A servant who obeys has done <u>nothing</u> special!
- 4. Faith is not just for transplanting trees (vs 4-6), but also the <u>routine tasks</u> of the day.
