Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

- 3. In Galatians 2:20, Paul explains why Jesus frees us from both the law and from sin. How would you explain this using your own words?
- 4. If we are living "by faith in the Son of God," how should we respond to the Coronavirus outbreak?
