

FAMILY DISCUSSION

Use the following questions this week to discuss the message as a family.

1. As we remember and think about what Jesus did for us when he died on the cross for our sins, what would you ask Jesus to do for you this week? Why is that important to you? Did you know Easter is coming next Sunday? What is your favorite Easter tradition? Easter Jam
2. As a family read the story of the Triumphal Entry in Matthew 21:1-16. What were the people expecting from Jesus. Think of a time when you were expecting something from Jesus and He gave you something different. What is your favorite thing about Jesus? What is your favorite story of Jesus from the Bible?
3. What do you believe Jesus is trying to change in your life or the life of our family during this time that we are at home together? What are some of the things that make it hard to live a life fully committed for Jesus that aren't happening right now because of the stay at home restrictions? Have you ever asked someone for something and they gave you something different? What was it? Were you happy? How did you react? Was it better for you? Jesus wants us to love God and love others. When we love others, that makes Jesus happy. What can you do to show Jesus how much you love Him?
4. What are some ways that we can prepare our hearts this week to get ready for Easter and hear from God in a new and fresh way? One way that we celebrate who Jesus is by singing worship songs to Him. What is your favorite worship song. Take a few moments as a family this week to sing everyone's favorite worship song together. How can we celebrate as a family this Good Friday and Easter? What can we do to remember and celebrate what Jesus did for us?
