## **MY APPLICATION**

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

- 1. When you hear about a life review, does that scare you, excite you, or both? Explain why.
- 2. Read Ephesians 2:8-10. A relationship with God is not based on works, it is God's gift to us. But what we do with our life is our gift back to God. When you think about that, how does that change what you thought in the past or motivate you for the future?
- 3. Jesus will reward you for what you do in this life. (See Matthew 16:27 and 1 Corinthians 4:4-5) How does that impact your priorities now?
- 4. What are you currently involved in that tends to get in the way of loving God and loving people? It could be something that keeps you busy, distracted, selfabsorbed, worried, etc.
