MY APPLICATION

- 2. If you were to explain to someone else what worship is, how would you describe it? Would you have described it any differently prior to today's message?
- 3. During worship today, can you share points where your mind, emotions, and will were all engaged? How so?
- 4. Read Deuteronomy 12:1-7. Why is it important to 'worship in the place of God?'
- 5. Read Deuteronomy 12:15, 20-21. Why is it important to 'worship in the place God puts you?'
