Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

- 1. How has the gospel interacted with you? Have you received the gospel? If so, how did it come to you, and how have you grown in the gospel over time?
- 2. Are there people you tend to (in your heart) think are less likely to receive the gospel? Does this prevent you from boldness with everyone?
- 3. How does reflecting on the gospel embolden you to share it with others?
- 4. Who in your life right now needs to hear the gospel? Of the three ways the gospel interacted with the characters in the story, which do you think they'll most likely receive? Each of them needs words (the gospel is the good news). Do you feel capable of sharing the basic story of Jesus?
