Small Group Discussion Guide

Key Scriptures: 1 Corinthians 3:16; 12:4-7

Group Opener:

Take a trip down Memory Lane: How do you resolve conflicts over the TV remote? Or... Growing up, what did you think “the Church” was, and how has your view changed?

Discuss:

1. When you hear someone say, “That person is gifted,” what do you picture?
2. Read 1 Corinthians 12:4-7, replacing the pronoun “you” with the second person plural, “y’all.” What stands out to you?
3. Do you ever struggle to believe that *you* are spiritually gifted by God? Why or why not?
4. The metaphor of the **temple built with many stones** points to our interdependence. How easy or hard is it for you to accept that *you* need *others* in your spiritual life, *and vice versa*?
5. How does the assertion—that every believer is gifted to reveal a piece of God to others—change the way we see ourselves (and each other) in our group, in our church, in our community?

Pray:

As we prepare to become three churches, how can you be part of reinforcing the idea that “the Church is the hope of the world,” even if we’re smaller?
