Acts 2 | Group Discussion Guide | September 14, 2025

Key Scripture: 2:42-47

Key Points on the Introduction to the book of Acts:

The same Spirit and the same mission given to the first disciples are given to us today. The Spirit comes. The gospel is preached. The church is born.

Group Opener: Think back to a time when you joined something new (a team, a class, a small group, or even a neighborhood). What helped you feel like you really belonged?

Discuss:

1. In Acts 2, we see a vivid description of the Holy Spirit's arrival. In what ways have you experienced the Holy Spirit's power in your life? In your group?
2. In Acts 2:38, we see Peter telling the crowd, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins..." What does repentance look like in your daily life as a follower of Jesus? Is there an area where you sense God calling you to turn back to Him this week?
3. **Read Acts 2:42-47.** The early believers devoted themselves to teaching, fellowship, meals, prayer, generosity, and worship, in the temple courts and often in each other's homes. Of the activities listed, what do you see your small group doing well? Which area would you like to grow in more intentionally?
4. Verse 47 says, "The Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved." Where have you seen God at work in the lives of people in your *oikos* recently? How might we join Him in what He's already doing?

Pray:

Pray about whichever area(s) mentioned in the discussion questions above you want to grow in most (seeing the Holy Spirit at work, repentance, fellowship, prayer, worship, generosity, sharing the good news of the gospel).
