Acts Week 6 | Group Discussion Guide | October 12, 2025

Group Opener: If you could step into any movie as the *main character* for one day, which movie would it be—and why?

Read Acts 9:1-22. Feel free to assign different sections (such as vv. 1-6, vv. 7-16, etc. to different individuals)

Discuss

1. What stages of Paul's "hero's journey" stand out most to you, and why?
2. Jesus called Paul *by name*, not to destroy him, but to transform him. When has God "called you out" of the way things were, maybe through conviction, change, or an invitation to a new step in faith?
3. Paul didn't wait to "have it all figured out," but immediately began sharing about Jesus. Pastor Tim said, "Sharing my faith grows my faith." How have you experienced that to be true?
4. Which part of Paul's "hero's journey" do you identify with most right now:
 - *Ordinary World* (stuck or striving)
 - *Call to Adventure* (hearing a nudge from God)
 - *Meeting a Mentor* (learning and growing)
 - *Crossing the Threshold* (acting in faith)
 - *Tests & Allies* (facing resistance or growth pains)

BONUS: Invite anyone who has been on a Global Outreach trip and would like to share about their experience to do so with the group.

Pray:

Thank God for calling each person by name. Ask for courage to cross the next threshold in obedience. Pray for the people in your *oikos*, your relational world, who might be ready to hear God's call through you.
