Acts Week 7 | Group Discussion Guide | October 19, 2025

Acts 10:1-48

1. God has prepared many different people to say yes to Him
2. There's a clear call for a shift in our beliefs
3. True shifts produce different actions

Group Opener: Where have you traveled internationally, or engaged with a culture different than yours?

Discuss

1. Read Acts 10: 34-43. What stands out to you about these verses, or what do you notice?
2. Peter was finding his identity in his Jewishness instead of his Jesus-ness. What do you tend to find your identity in?
3. God talks to Peter about a shift needed in his beliefs and actions. Are there any shifts in your beliefs or actions that you have sensed God nudging you toward lately?
4. God is calling us to be ethnos-centric (other people focused) not ethnocentric (evaluating other peoples and cultures according to the standards of one's own culture). And there's a difference between being around people rather than engaging them. How can you take a step to engage the nations this week?

Our God is a global God. Here are some ways to engage:

- Enter into the world of others that are different from you. (*Ex: go to an Indian food restaurant and invite someone to share about their home country.*)
