**Acts Week 8** | Group Discussion Guide | October 26, 2025

Acts 11:19-30

**Group Opener:** What is a skill you have that others may or may not know about?

## **Discuss**

1. Read Acts 11:19-30. What do you notice, or what stands out to you?
2. The church in Antioch was the first truly multi-ethnic congregation. What are some barriers (personal, cultural, or relational) that can make unity across differences difficult, and how can we overcome them?
3. Barnabas and Saul stayed in Antioch for a year, grounding new believers in their faith. How can we as a church or small group help each other move beyond initial belief toward spiritual maturity and obedience?
4. When the Antioch believers heard about the famine in Judea, they gave according to their ability to help others in need. When you hear about needs — whether close to home or far away — how do you decide whether or how to respond?
5. Considering how God used the believers in Antioch. What is one specific way you sense God calling *you* to live out your faith this week in your own context?

## **Pray:**

Pray that God would make us, Hill Country Bible Church, a church like the church in Antioch. Pray that the gospel would spread when ordinary people trust God's hand and act. Pray that we would say "yes" to Him, even when it's uncomfortable, even when we think we don't have enough. Pray that we would be diverse, united, obedient, generous, and fully committed to God's mission.
