

Own The Fight 2 Timothy 2:1-13

A life of purpose relies on God's grace to be strong and passes on truth to others who will faithfully pass on truth (1-2).

A life of purpose knows the cost and is willing to take the risk (3-7).

A life of purpose is motivated by the gospel and is willing to endure everything for some to be saved (8-13).

Own the Truth:

A life of purpose chooses to endure, motivated and strengthened by the gospel, so that others may be saved.
