## Scripture: John 4:25-26

The woman said, "I know that Messiah" (called Christ) is coming. When He comes, He will explain everything to us." <sup>26</sup> Then Jesus declared, "I, the one speaking to you—I am He."

Sermon Points: Jesus showed the world how God values women

- 1. Jesus valued women as persons (John 4:7-10, 25-30)
- 2. Jesus valued women as disciples (Luke 8:1-3 & 10:38-42)
- 3. Jesus valued women as witnesses (Matthew 28:8-10)

Group Opener: How did you celebrate Mother's Day this weekend?

## Discussion Questions:

- Christ followers value what Jesus valued! What are some ways you've seen women de-valued?
  How do you think Jesus felt about that?
- 2. Jesus first identified Himself as Messiah to the Samaritan Woman at the well in John 4:26. How does this confirm her value as a person?
- 3. Women were welcomed as disciples by Jesus. Read Luke 8:1-3 What do you think about Jesus' coed traveling ministry team? How does this passage value women?
- 4. The first witnesses of Jesus' resurrection were the women from Luke8. How does their faithfulness to Jesus strike you?
