Week Five: Home Invasion

Text: 1 John 4:7-9 & Selected Scriptures

Sermon Summary:

Teaching points:

- 1. Love is a <u>commitment</u> we keep.
- 2. Life is a <u>gift</u> we receive.

Discussion Questions:

These three larger questions will drive our discussion:

- 1. What did the Holy Spirit say to you through Sunday's sermon?
- 2. What are you going to do about it?
- 3. How can others help you and pray for you so you can do what God told you?

What did the Holy Spirit say to you through the sermon?

- If you were consulting Satan about how to undermine God's plan for humanity, what advice would you give him? Do you see any of your ideas already being used by Satan against us?
- What would you say is his worst cultural lie that is hurting the people in our nation?
- Do you tend to think of a good marriage as mostly chemistry or commitment? Based on 1 John 4:7-12 and Corinthians 13:4-8a, how would you define the word love?

What are you going to do about it?

- How does making a commitment to love someone help the person making the commitment as much as it helps the one to whom the commitment is made?
- How do the Bible and culture differ on what children need from their parents? In what ways do you think Satan is using the expectation from the culture to distract parents from what children need the most?
- If someone told you they don't require their children to participate in church and other spiritual growth activities because they don't want their kids to reject God in the future, how would you respond? Why?

How can others in this group help you or pray for you?

- In what ways do you need to trust God and stand against the negative influences of our culture?
- How can others in your small group help you and pray for you to focus better on God and His will for you?
