Read Proverbs 31:10-31. The book of Proverbs is a book of wisdom literature. It presents simple truths, rather than promises, about daily life. Proverbs 31 describes a woman who fears the Lord. Such a woman is almost a personification of wisdom.

Jot down notes on the passage, specifically words or ideas that are repeated in the passage.

Questions to consider:

1. No doubt, the Proverbs 31 woman is a busy lady. What makes her stand out (28-30)?
2. This woman does do many things, what things do you find noteworthy or interesting? Challenging?
3. As you consider your priorities, are there some that are misplaced?
4. Are there distractions that keep you from Jesus?
5. What action do you need to take to make Jesus and God's Word the good portion of your life?
6. What lies are you believing or tempted to believe about your priorities and time?
7. What truth do you need to plant about your priorities and time?
