Planting Truth & Uprooting Lies

Read Proverbs 31:10-31. The book of Proverbs is a book of wisdom literature. It presents simple truths, rather than promises, about daily life. Proverbs 31 describes a woman who fears the Lord. Such a woman is almost a personification of wisdom.

Jot down notes on the passage, specifically words or ideas that are repeated in the passage.

Questions to consider:

- 1. No doubt, the Proverbs 31 woman is a busy lady. What makes her stand out (28-30)?
- 2. This woman does do many things, what things do you find noteworthy or interesting? Challenging?
- 3. As you consider your priorities, are there some that are misplaced?
- 4. Are there distractions that keep you from Jesus?
- 5. What action do you need to take to make Jesus and God's Word the good portion of your life?
- 6. What lies are you believing or tempted to believe about your priorities and time?
- 7. What truth do you need to plant about your priorities and time?
