This Is a Day of Good News! 2 Kings 6:24-7:16 (NIV)

- Life outside of a relationship with God is <u>miserable</u>.
- Sharing the truth might make you the subject of someone's <u>anger</u>.
- God is capable of <u>so much</u> more than you can imagine!
- BIG QUESTION: Will I tell dying people <u>Good News</u> that God has miraculously provided an opportunity for <u>life</u>?
- Some people <u>won't</u> believe the Good News....Some <u>will</u>.

2 Kings 7:9-11 (ESV)

⁹Then they said to each other, "What we're doing is not right. This is a day of good news and we are keeping it to ourselves. If we wait until daylight, punishment will overtake us. Let's go at once and report this to the royal palace."

¹⁰ So they went and called out to the city gatekeepers and told them, "We went into the Aramean camp and no one was there—not a sound of anyone—only tethered horses and donkeys, and the tents left just as they were." ¹¹ The gatekeepers shouted the news, and it was reported within the palace.
