**Daniel 8:15-19; 27 (ESV)**

1. Greatness in own mind (v. 25)
2. Deceit will prosper (v. 25)
3. Fear and destruction will be widespread (v. 24)

6. God's sanctuary will be given over to the evil one (v. 13)
7. The times will be inspired by the evil one (v. 11; 24; 25)
8. Truth will be thrown to the ground (v. 12)

### **Daniel 8:15-19; 27 (ESV)**

<sup>15</sup> When I, Daniel, had seen the vision, I sought to understand it. And behold, there stood before me one having the appearance of a man. <sup>16</sup>And I heard a man's voice between the banks of the Ulai, and it called, "Gabriel, make this man understand the vision." <sup>17</sup>So he came near where I stood. And when he came, I was frightened and fell on my face. But he said to me, "Understand, O son of man, that the vision is for the time of the end." <sup>18</sup>And when he had spoken to me, I fell into a deep sleep with my face to the ground. But he touched me and made me stand up. <sup>19</sup>He said, "Behold, I will make known to you what shall be at the latter end of the indignation, for it refers to the appointed time of the end.

<sup>27</sup>And I, Daniel, was overcome and lay sick for some days. Then I rose and went about the king's business, but I was appalled by the vision and did not understand it.
