Flip the Script Luke 19:1-10 (NIV)

The Gospel According to Matthew

Focus on Jesus as the **heir** of King David and the long-awaited Jewish Messiah.

The Gospel According to Mark

Focus on Jesus as the **suffering** servant who died as a ransom for sinners

The Gospel According to John

Focus on Jesus as the **Word** ("Logos") who has come to reveal the Father and to bring eternal life to all who follow Him.

The Gospel According to Luke

Focus on Jesus as the Messiah and Lord Whose life, death, and resurrection make salvation available to **all** people **everywhere**.

Jesus' Ministry to the Poor throughout His Ministry

- The **Rich** Young Ruler (Luke 18:18-30)
- A Blind **Beggar** Receives His Sight (Luke 18:35-43)
