<sup>16</sup>Behold, you are beautiful, my beloved, truly delightful. Our couch is green;<sup>17</sup>the beams of our house are cedar; our rafters are pine. **2** I am a rose of Sharon, a lily of the valleys. <sup>2</sup>As a lily among brambles, so is my love among the young women. <sup>3</sup>As an apple tree among the trees of the forest, so is my beloved among the young men. With great delight I sat in his shadow, and his fruit was sweet to my taste. <sup>4</sup>He brought me to the banqueting house, and his banner over me was love.<sup>5</sup>Sustain me with raisins; refresh me with apples, for I am sick with love. <sup>6</sup>His left hand is under my head, and his right hand embraces me! <sup>7</sup>I adjure you, O daughters of Jerusalem, by the gazelles or the does of the field, that you not stir up or awaken love until it pleases.
