## 13 Biblical Teaching About Tongues—1 Corinthians 14

- 1. Tongues are to build up the church (vv. 5; 12)
- 2. It is better to say 5 words with your mind than 10,000 words in tongues (v. 19)
- 3. Do not be childlike in thinking about tongues (v. 20)
- 4. Tongues are a sign to unbelievers not believers (v. 22)
- 5. There should only be 2 tongue-speakers in a service, at most 3 (v. 27)
- 6. Tongue speakers are to speak one at a time (v. 27)
- 7. Someone is to interpret the tongues (v. 27)
- 8. If no one is there to interpret, keep silent (v. 28)
- 9. Weigh what is said (v. 29)
- 10. The gift of tongues is a lesser gift. Proclamation rather than tongues is how you learn and are encouraged (v. 31)
- 11. Tongues should bring peace not confusion to a congregation (v. 33)
- 12. Long after proclamation rather than tongues (v. 39)
- 13. All things should be decently and in order in the worship services (v. 40)

## 1 Corinthians 14:26-33 (ESV)

<sup>26</sup> What then, brothers? When you come together, each one has a hymn, a lesson, a revelation, a tongue, or an interpretation. Let all things be done for building up. <sup>27</sup> If any speak in a tongue, let there be only two or at most three, and each in turn, and let someone interpret. <sup>28</sup> But if there is no one to interpret, let each of them keep silent in church and speak to himself and to God. <sup>29</sup> Let two or three prophets speak, and let the others weigh what is said. <sup>30</sup> If a revelation is made to another sitting there, let the first be silent. <sup>31</sup> For you can all prophesy one by one, so that all may learn and all be encouraged, <sup>32</sup> and the spirits of prophets are subject to prophets. <sup>33</sup> For God is not a God of confusion but of peace.
