Isaiah's name means: "THE LORD IS SALVATION"

His name means the same as: **JOSHUA**, **ELISHA**, **and JESUS** 

Isaiah is a major prophet in the Bible. He is quoted over <u>SIXTY</u> <u>FIVE</u> times in and his name is mentioned <u>TWENTY ONE</u> times in the New Testament, which is far more than any other prophet. He prophesied during the reign of <u>FOUR</u> kings from 739BC until 686BC.

Isaiah's Prophesies Fulfilled...

- **1)** He prophesied that **SENNACHERIB**, the king of Assyria, would fail in his attempt to capture Jerusalem.
- **2)** He prophesied that **HEZEKIAH**, the king of Judah, would be healed of his critical illness.
- **3)** He prophesied that **CRYUS**, the king of Persia, would be the instrument that God would use to free Judah from Babylonian captivity.

**4)** He prophesied both the first and second coming of **JESUS**, which the first has been fulfilled and the second is yet to come.

The **TRINITY** is always involved in the salvation event.

- 1) It is God's **PLAN** that leads to salvation
- **2)** It is Jesus' **SACRIFICIAL**, **ATONING** death on the cross that leads to salvation.
- **3)** It is the Holy Spirit's **<u>DRAWING</u>** men to repentance that leads to salvation.

Jesus came to set **TWO** kinds of people free!!!

- 1) Jesus came to set lost people free from their sin of **UNBELIEF**.
  - a) He came to set people free from the **POWER** of sin.
  - b) He came to set people free from the **PENALTY** of sin.
- **2)** Jesus came to set saved people free from their sin of **WORLDLINESS**.
  - **a)** He came to set saved people free from the **TRAPPINGS** of this world.
  - **b)** Jesus came to set saved people free from the **SELF- ABSORPTION** of this world.
