### Unbridled Joy: Contentment Is The Key To Joy Philippians 4:10-19

**v.10** – I rejoiced in the Lord greatly that now at length you have revived your concern for me

**v.11** – For I learned in whatever situation I am to be content

Contentment is being so \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ you cannot be \_\_\_\_\_ with anything else.

**v.13** – I can do all things through Him who strengthens me

#### Four characteristics in learning contentment:

2. \_\_\_\_\_ - think about Christ constantly.

3. \_\_\_\_\_ - spend time with Christ endlessly.

4. \_\_\_\_\_ - obey Christ diligently.

#### Contentment = godly power + Christ-like faith.

**v.15** – No church entered into partnership with me in giving and receiving, except you only

**v.17** – Not that I seek the gift, but I seek the fruit that increases to your credit

Contentment is a \_\_\_\_\_ to those who cheerfully and regularly \_\_\_\_\_.

**v.18** – I have received full payment, and more. I am well supplied, having received from Epaphroditus the gifts you sent, a fragrant offering, a sacrifice acceptable and pleasing to God.

\_\_\_\_\_ meets the needs of His people through His \_\_\_\_\_ and from His \_\_\_\_\_.

**v.19** – And my God will supply every need of yours

#### Contentment is the reality that Christ is enough.

**v.19** – According to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus
