Think about a time when you missed a good opportunity. Read Deuteronomy 1:21, 32-33 NIV. What would it be like to see your parents disobey God's plan for their life?

Read Deuteronomy 3:25-27 NIV and notice how frustrated Moses is as he talks to God. Moses is blaming the people because he can't join them in the promised land, but was his part? (Read Numbers 20:1-13 NIV). Do you ever wonder if disobeying God limits what you can do in the future?

Read Deuteronomy 4:1-2,9 NIV. Did God give rules to the Israelite people to make their lives harder or to make them better?

Just as God saved the Israelites, He has made a way for us to be saved through Jesus. Read Philippians 2:5-11 NIV. Because of what Jesus has done for you, are you willing to make changes to follow Him more closely especially right now?
