MY APPLICATION

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

- Describe a time when someone disrespected you. What did you feel? Why? Does God take our disrespect personally?
- 2. Read Isaiah 5. As you read the six woes in 5:8-23, what are some areas of your life that need to change?
- 3. How does God feel when we are worshipping as we live in unconfessed sin? See Isaiah 1:10-17. Are there areas of your life that may need some evaluation?
- 4. What does it look like to live a life that respects God? Be as specific as possible.
