## **MY APPLICATION**

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

- 1. How are you personally doing during this COVID-19 crisis? What are your greatest concerns now and long-term?
- 2. In Psalm 4, why does David have so much confidence in God? Think of a time in your life when God came through for you in a dramatic way. What is the greatest expression of His faithfulness to us? (Hint: Romans 5:8)
- 3. Read Psalm 4:3-5. What is the choice David must make in his crisis? Are there internal choices that you are struggling with today? What would it mean for you to "Offer right sacrifices and trust in the Lord?" (v. 4)
- 4. Does your joy leave when things go badly for you? What things has God done to prepare you for this crisis? What things does God want to reshape in you? Is the "light of His face" enough for you? (v. 6)
