MY APPLICATION

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

1. People having near death experiences frequently reference coming into a bright light and finding that light to be love. Many identify that light as God and even Jesus. Examine these Scriptures and notice the focus on light. (Ezekiel 1:26-28; Daniel 10:4-6; Isaiah 9:1-6; John 1:4-9; John 8:12; Revelation 1:13-16)
2. As you think about what drives people, how much does the longing for love play a part in our motivation? If heaven is a place where the God of love fully satisfies your desire to be love and give love, how will that heal some of the times you have been brokenhearted in your life?
3. Do you normally think of God as personal? Read Zephaniah 3:17. What insights do you get from this verse?
4. What could you do this week to deepen your personal love relationship with Jesus? Who are some people that you could introduce to Jesus this week?
