- 3. If suffering on earth is the result of humans going against God's will, and it's a loving warning for people to turn to God, does that motivate you to seek and follow God's will? Why or why not?
- 4. Knowing that humans face eternity with God or without God, how does that motivate you to help others to know God? What would keep you from helping others know about God?
