MY APPLICATION

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

1. This week's shift is from more guilt to more love. Share about a time when you were motivated by guilt? What was the circumstance and what ended up happening? Why is guilt such a negative motivation?
2. Read Ephesians 3:16-17a. Why, as we live out our masterpiece mission, do we need the strength only God can provide? Can you think of an example of receiving God's inner strength?
3. Read Ephesians 3:17b-19. In your own words, what does it look like to be "rooted and established in love?" Can you think of a time when you deeply sensed God's love, or maybe felt overcome by it?
4. Read Ephesians 3:20-21. What encourages you in these verses? Why do we need to know that, in our living out our masterpiece mission, God is the one who can do "immeasurably more?"
5. Talk in your group about what you think your masterpiece mission might be. What does that look like? What is your next step to live that out?
