MY APPLICATION

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

- When you think of the church, what commonly comes to mind? According to the Bible, what is the church? How do our cultural definitions of church negatively impact our view of God's plan for each of us?
- 2. The gospel is not only about getting people into heaven, it is also about how Christians live out their lives here on earth. Read Ephesians 1:22-23, 2:8-10, 3:7-8, and 4:7-12. What insights do you gain from these passages of the Bible?
- 3. Describe your masterpiece mission (the good works God created for you to do with your life). If you are still on a journey to find it, share how you are seeking it. If you know what it is but have gotten off track, invite the group to pray for you to get back on track.
- 4. What do you think would happen if all the believers who make up Hill Country Bible Church were actively growing and living out their faith? Discuss how each person in your family or group can take their next step spiritually.
