

Week Four (6/27/21): Jesus Rescues Sinners

Scripture Text: John 21:1-17

Does it make sense to you that confession of our sins to Jesus should end in joy as we remember the gospel? When we consider Jesus' heart for us, we can see that we're covered in love, grace, mercy, and more. Think of it this way: Jesus' heart is to rescue us from sin, restore us to relationship, and recommission us to our call.

Sermon Points:

Jesus' heart toward sinners is to...

- o ...rescue us from sin
- o ...restore us to relationship
- o ...recommission us to our call

Discussion Question Options:

- What is one point that stood out to you from this message?
- Share about a time when you made a mistake and you didn't receive grace or mercy. What happened? How did you feel?
- Read John 21:15-17. What does this incident show about how Jesus feels about us when we sin?
- Is confession of sin a regular conversation you have with Jesus? Why? How does the idea that confession should end in joy change your feelings about it?
- In verses 15-17 Jesus recommissions Peter to ministry. How could someone's past make them feel unqualified to serve God? How did Peter's failure actually equip him for his mission?
- How might a "confession conversation" with Jesus help you discover His mission for you?
