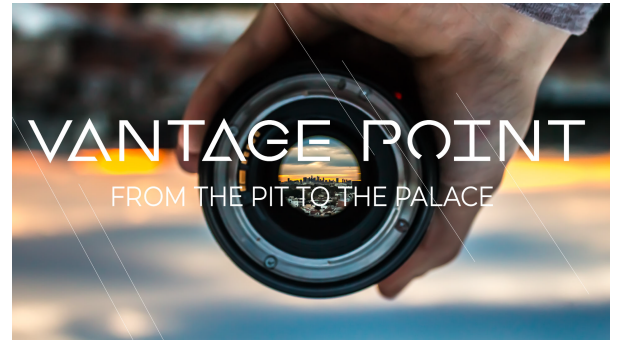

Read Genesis 39:18-23 NIV. Why is it important for believers to make a daily relationship with God a priority? Share how you personally spend time with God each day and think of one thing you could add to it to help you grow closer to God.
