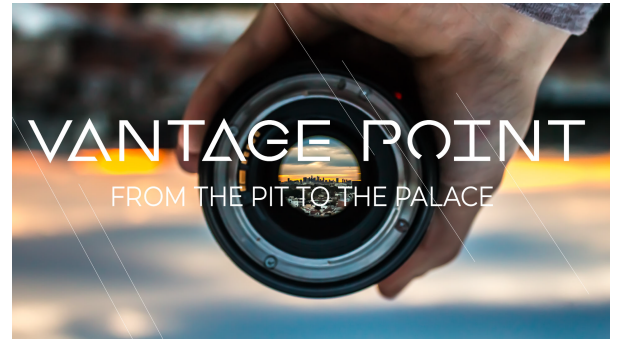

Read Genesis 42:36-38 NIV. We see Jacob displaying faithlessness. How are you doing with your faith in God right now? Make a list of four promises God has made to you in the Bible.
