Week Six (5/23/21): Made To Do More

Scripture Text: Ephesians 6

Paul explains the battle of this world, not just physically but spiritually as well. He urges us to armor up for battle, ready to stand our ground strong and firm in the strength of the Lord. He directs us to pray for one another consistently, depending on God's strength.

Sermon Points:

Key Shift: More Strategy → More Surrender

1. Be strengthened in God's power
2. Stand our ground in God's armor
3. Pray persistently, seeking God's help

Discussion Question Options:

- Out of the six weeks of Made for More, what concept has stuck with you the most?
- Read Eph 6:10-13, where we're told that "our struggle is not against flesh and blood." How does this help us reframe how we look at difficulties in our lives?
- Read Eph 6:14-17. Talk about a time when you were able to "stand your ground." What enabled you to do that?
- We often think through the armor of God by zooming in on the nuances of each piece. In Sunday's message, we heard how the entire set of spiritual armor counters the schemes of the evil one. Can you share an example of how you've experienced this in your life?
 - Truth vs. Lies
 - Righteousness vs. Sin
 - Readiness vs. Procrastination
 - Faith vs. Doubt
 - Salvation vs. Failure
 - God's Word vs. Heresy
- As we wrap up Made for More, let's end as Ephesians 6 directs us to stand together, praying for one another side by side in community. Spend a few moments praying together as a group, over your individual Masterpiece Missions, over your FRANC lists, and for the strength to stand on the winning side of the battle!
