Sermon Notes

- 1. In life we're continually giving offerings; if not to God, than to ourselves, the world, or the devil.
- 2. Principle One: Grace Giving is dependent upon faith not circumstances or income.
- 3. Circumstances are always right for faith! It knows no barriers, while unbelief never has enough proof.
- 4. Principle Two: Grace Giving exceeds human capability.
- 5. When faith is willing to sow God supplies the seeds.
- 6. Principle Three: Grace Giving is always voluntary.
- 7. Grace Giving is an echo of the cross, not the Law.
- 8. Principle Four: Grace Giving is seen as privilege, not burden.
- 9. Grace Giving doesn't consider cost but effect. It doesn't look at what the seed costs, but what the harvest is worth!
- 10. Principle Five: Grace Giving is the result of first giving yourself to the Lord and by extension, the Lords' people.
