## **Sermon Notes**

- 1. Scripture mentions two types of giving: offerings and tithes.
- Under the Old Covenant Law God commanded Israel to tithe. (Leviticus 27: 30-34)
- 3. The tithe was a tax, and one of several.
- 4. The tithe is now obsolete. (Hebrews 8:13) We're not a nation state under Law given through Moses, but the church under grace given through Jesus. (Romans 6:14)
- 5. Under New Covenant grace believers desire to give because we have a new nature, a new perspective, and the Holy Spirit as our teacher.
- 6. Believers will desire to give all they can, to meet as many needs as they can, in order to glorify God as much as they can.
- 7. Grace giving allows for differing circumstances.
- 8. Giving is worship.
- 9. Belief and practice are the only cures for our worship problem!
- 10. We worship God because our hearts are assured of His goodwill toward us; we love because He first loved us; and give, because He gave.
- 11. The answer to "How much should I give" is ultimately "How much do you want to bless God and others, and be blessed yourself?"
