Scripture: ²⁷So God created human beings in his own image. In the image of God, he created them; male and female he created them. ²⁸Then God blessed them and said, "Be fruitful and multiply. Fill the earth and govern it... [Genesis 1:27-28a NLT]

1. God created and embodied human sexuality as male and female.

²⁴This explains why a man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into one. [Genesis 2:24 NLT]

2. God created marriage as a faithful <u>covenant</u> relationship between one <u>man</u> and one <u>woman</u> for a lifetime.

⁷At that moment their eyes were opened, and they suddenly felt shame at their nakedness. [Genesis 3:7a NLT]

- 3. Humanity's disobedience brought sexual brokenness.
- 4. Christ's obedience brings sexual wholeness.

- 4. Have you ever been set free from bondage to sexual sin? Explain.
- 5. What did you find most challenging, helpful, or inspiring in the sermon today and why?
